

Summary of ICAPGen's Testing Levels

The following table describes the fees and testing requirements associated with ICAPGen's three testing levels.

* The \$50 subsequent attempt fee applies for one year from the time the fee was paid. After one year, the next subsequent attempt will require the full fee.
